The Louisville Metro Meals On Wheels Program serves approximately 500 hot, nutritious meals daily to eligible homebound seniors.

Eligibility for Home-Delivered Meals:

- An individual aged 60 or over
- The spouse of someone aged 60 or over
- Someone under 60 who is a dependent of and resides with a homebound individual who is aged 60 or over
- Is unable to attend a congregate site
- Does not have a person in the home able to prepare a nutritious meal on a regular basis
- Must be a resident of Louisville/Jefferson County
