

**Establishments with a Policy Prohibiting the Use of Electronic Cigarettes:**

<b>Healthcare</b>	
Norton Healthcare	<p>The use of tobacco products including cigarettes, cigars, pipes, herbal tobacco products, electronic and smokeless cigarettes and chewing tobacco is prohibited on any Norton Healthcare campus.</p> <p>Norton Healthcare campuses includes all owned buildings and grounds, leased facilities, parking garages, parking lots, and any public space, such as public sidewalks within 150 feet of any owned or leased building's entry or exit. Smoking and the use of any other tobacco products is prohibited in Norton Healthcare vehicles at all times and in the use of employees' personal vehicles while on company paid time performing company business. Employees, patients, visitors, volunteers, and contract vendors are also prohibited from smoking in personal vehicles while on a Norton Healthcare campus.</p>
Kindred Healthcare	<p>This policy is applicable to all employees, staff, visitors and patients, both smokers and those individuals who use smokeless tobacco products (including electronic cigarettes). Smoking of any tobacco product and the use of electronic cigarettes and smokeless tobacco products are not permitted in any Kindred building or on facility grounds by visitors and hospital staff. Smoking: Hereafter designates the smoking or use of any kind of tobacco product, the use of smokeless tobacco products and the use of electronic cigarettes.</p>
KentuckyOne Health	<p>The use or sale of all tobacco products (cigarettes, electronic devices including electronic cigarettes, cigars, pipes and all types of smokeless tobacco) is prohibited in or on all KentuckyOne Health premises. "Premises" is defined as all KentuckyOne</p>

	Health owned and leased buildings, grounds, parking areas and vehicles. The policy applies to all employees, contract employees, volunteers, physicians/allied health professionals visitors, students, contractors, and/or anyone entering the identified premises.
Seven Counties Services	Will refrain from tobacco use on SCS premises and during paid work time. Tobacco – cigarettes, pipes, pipe tobacco, tobacco substitutes (e. g., clove cigarettes), chewing tobacco, cigars, and e-cigarettes. SCS facilities or properties including but not limited to: service delivery buildings, clinics, facilities, office buildings, parking lots, SCS-owned or –leased vehicles used to transport passengers at any time or SCS property leased or rented out to other entities. Workplace also includes off-site locations at which SCS staff members and individuals and/or family members are engaged in care, treatment or service activities. This procedure applies regardless of whether an SCS facility or property is owned and whether or not other tenants follow similar guidelines. Workplace does not include one’s own vehicle, except when parked on SCS premises.
Baptist Healthcare	Leadership just approved an updated smoking policy last week that includes e-cigarettes. The policy covers all aspects of Baptist campuses – inside and out. The policy is awaiting signature, so it’s not official. (But we don’t expect any issues.) I am unable to share a full policy outside of our organization.
<b>Education</b>	
Jefferson County Public Schools	Use of Tobacco to include e-cigarettes JCPS BOE Policy 03.1327, JCPS BOE Policy 03.2327
Jefferson Community and Technical	The tobacco-free policy applies to all areas of

College	campus prohibits the use of all tobacco products on all grounds and parking areas (traditional cigarettes, e-cigarettes, chewing tobacco, pipes, cigars, snuff, etc.)
University of Louisville	Language does not mention e-cigarettes or hookah specifically but policy states “smoking of any substance is not allowed on any of the U of L campuses,” including “any other product that produces smoke”
Sullivan University	TOBACCO-FREE WORKPLACE - It is the policy of The Sullivan University System to prohibit the use of tobacco products in all buildings owned or leased by The Sullivan University System. Smoking is prohibited within a reasonable distance from the outside entrance to any building so as to ensure that tobacco smoke does not enter the building through entrances, windows, ventilation systems, or other means. The reference of tobacco products within this policy is inclusive of e-cigarettes and similar vaporized devices.
Bellarmine University	Tobacco use is not permitted in any University buildings, on the campus property, or in University owned vehicles. Tobacco products means all forms of tobacco including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, e-cigarettes, water pipes (hookahs), electronic cigarettes and smokeless tobacco products

Spalding University	Smoking of any kind and tobacco use are not permitted in any University building, on the campus property, or in University-owned vehicles. Tobacco products means all forms of tobacco including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, water pipes (hookahs), electronic cigarettes, and smokeless tobacco products. The smoking of any substance is prohibited on university property including vehicles and off campus events.
<b>Activities and Points of Interest</b>	
Louisville Zoo	Smoking (tobacco and e-cigarettes) is prohibited throughout the Zoo except in several designated areas.
KFC Yum! Center	Smoking is not allowed in any area of the building including its exterior balconies. Electronic cigarettes are also not allowed.
Papa John's Cardinal Stadium	The use of tobacco products (i.e. smoking, chewing tobacco, etc.) along with electric cigarettes, is strictly prohibited, as well as within 50 feet of an exterior gate or entrance.
Kentucky Kingdom and Hurricane Bay	Smoking (including the use of electronic cigarettes) is permitted only in designated areas.
Louisville Mega Cavern	Do not have any written policy other that we do not allow tobacco use of any kind inside of the cavern. Anything that emits "smoke" is not allowed because of the nature of our facility.
Louisville Slugger Field	Louisville Slugger Field is a controlled smoking facility; for those fans who wish to smoke, we have a designated smoking area on the Preston Street Patio for your convenience. This policy includes all electronic smoking devices.
The Kentucky Center for the Arts	Smoking is not permitted at any place on The Kentucky Center's property, including within The

	<p>Kentucky Center building, the garage, and in company vehicles. The Center will follow all state and local laws that restrict smoking in the work environment. ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES - The vapor produced by electronic cigarettes does contain nicotine and propylene glycol and pending further testing by the FDA may also contain carcinogenic tobacco-specific nitrosamines (TSNAs) and diethylene glycol. Due to the risk of exposure to those chemicals by second hand inhalation, electronic cigarettes will be treated in the same manner as other smoking products by The Kentucky Center. Policy prohibiting e-cigs has been in effect for approximately two years now.</p>
<p>Louisville Free Public Library</p>	<p>For the comfort and safety of patrons, volunteers and staff, and the protection of library property, the following actions are examples of conduct not allowed on library property: Smoking, chewing, rolling cigarettes, and other tobacco use, or the use of electronic cigarettes on library property except in designated areas.</p>
<p>Louisville Metro Parks and Recreation</p>	<p>Prohibits tobacco use at all our playgrounds, spray grounds, splash pads, and athletic fields where children are present. This policy covers all tobacco products from cigarettes, cigars, bidis, pipes and related devices, chews and related products, and e-cigarettes.</p>
<p>Louisville Slugger Museum and Factory</p>	<p>Do not specifically refer to electronic cigarettes in our no smoking policy. It's just no smoking, regardless of whether it's a regular cigarette or electronic. We have not had any issues with it yet.</p>
<p>The Louisville Palace</p>	<p>Adheres to the Live Nation policy regarding smoking and E-Cigarettes. E-cigs are not at all allowed for EDM shows and subject to designated smoking areas on all other shows.</p>

The Mercury Ballroom	Adheres to the Live Nation policy regarding smoking and E-Cigarettes. E-cigs are not at all allowed for EDM shows and subject to designated smoking areas on all other shows.
Xscape Theaters	We do not allow vaping inside of our establishment and we handle this the same way we handle smoking. We don't currently have an E-Cig policy for distribution. If someone is vaping in the theatre we just ask them to stop and to put it away.
<b>Rental Facilities</b>	
The Ice House	We don't currently have a policy on this is place, but we would ask anyone smoking their E Cig onsite to please take it outside.
<b>Hotels</b>	
The Seelbach Hilton	The Seelbach is a smoke free workplace. The use of e-cigarettes and related products is prohibited.
<b>Retail Stores</b>	
Kroger	E-cigs are not specifically mentioned in Kroger's policies but we consider them the same as regular cigarettes. Neither e-cigs or regular cigarettes are allowed to be used inside of our facilities. Each store has a designated outdoor space where smoking is allowed. The policy simply states – "Smoking is allowed only in the authorized smoking area during breaks or meal periods."
<b>Employers</b>	
Ford Kentucky Truck Plant	Electronic cigarettes are battery-powered devices that generally contain cartridges filled with nicotine, flavor and other chemicals. There have been no clinical studies presented to the FDA verifying the safety of these devices. Therefore, the health effects on either the people who use these products

	<p>or the people around them who are exposed to the vapors are unknown. At this time electronic cigarettes are included as a product that cannot be utilized inside Kentucky Truck Plant. As with regular cigarettes, should you choose to smoke you must be at least 15 feet from all plant entrances. Smoking on any rooftop surface is strictly prohibited.</p>
Brown-Forman	<p>Tobacco free workplace companywide policy includes the use of cigarettes, cigars, pipes, smokeless tobacco products, electronic cigarettes and all other tobacco products. Tobacco use is prohibited in all company buildings, company-owned vehicles, at company social functions conducted off-site and applies to all employees, service providers, and visitors.</p>
Humana	<p>To promote a healthy workplace environment, all Humana facilities are tobacco-free. No forms of tobacco use are permitted inside Humana facilities. This includes the use of electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes) and any other vapor products.</p>
<b>Faith Communities</b>	
Highland Baptist Church	<p>Although we do not allow smoking of any kind inside our building, we do not have a written policy.</p>
Southeast Christian Church	<p>We do not allow smoking, including use of electronic cigarettes, in our buildings. We do not have a ban outside of the buildings. We do not have a written policy.</p>
<b>Other</b>	
Louisville International Airport	<p>Persons shall smoke only at those places on the Airport where smoking is permitted by posted signs and where it is not in violation of Federal, state, or local law. Electronic cigarettes are implicitly included in our currently smoking policy.</p>

Kentucky State Property	No cigarettes, tobacco products or e-cigarettes may be used in state-owned or leased buildings, in state-owned vehicles or on state property (including parking lots, sidewalks, and green space).
