WHO WE ARE

Our counselors are certified alcohol and drug counselors specializing in medication assisted treatment. Our Medical Director is a Distinguished Fellow of the American Society of Addiction Medicine and a member of the American Board of Addiction Medicine.

We adhere to rigorous monitoring and standards set forth by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, and the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration.

Because we are a nonprofit, our fees are lower than those charged by private treatment facilities. Our funding comes from federal grants, patient fees, and insurance. We accept Medicaid and private insurance.


WHAT WE DO

We treat opioid use disorders (addiction) with a combination of psychosocial counseling and medication. Our Medical Director, an addiction specialist, and nursing staff, will assist you in finding a safe, stabilizing, daily dose of methadone that allows you to avoid withdrawal symptoms so you can begin rebuilding your life. Recovery is possible. We want to help you.

Methadone has been the gold standard for treatment of opiate addiction for decades. Research showing its effectiveness has been established for over forty years. Women who are pregnant and addicted to opiates are frequently referred to medication assisted treatment for improved health of their baby during pregnancy.

SERVICES OFFERED

- Visits with a physician
- Weekly counseling sessions
- Dosing supervised by a registered nurse
- Pregnancy medication treatment
- Resources and referrals to other social and healthcare supports
- Sliding fee payment scale
