

LEGAL NOTICE NOTICE OF PLANNED REAPPORTIONMENT

In accordance with the provisions of KRS 67C.103, KRS 67C.135, and KRS Chapter 424, notice is given that the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Council (hereafter "Metro Council") plans to reapportion the boundary lines for the twenty-six (26) Metro Council legislative districts. Boundary lines shall be drawn so that the districts are compact and contiguous and the population of each district shall be as nearly equal as is reasonably possible. Whenever possible, each district shall respect existing neighborhood, community, and city boundaries.

The President of the Metro Council will appoint council members to the Metro Council Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting. This appointment will be done at a meeting on July 27, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. at the City Hall building, 601 W. Jefferson Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40202. This meeting will take place in the Metro Council chambers on the third floor.

The Metro Council Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting will hold its first meeting on July 28, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. This meeting will take place at the City Hall building, 601 W. Jefferson Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40202. The meeting will be held in the Metro Council chambers on the third floor. This meeting will begin the Committee's process. The schedule of subsequent meetings for the Metro Council Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting will be posted on the Metro Council website:

After the Metro Council Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting finishes its work, it will propose an ordinance to the Metro Council. This proposed ordinance will set out the boundary lines for the 26 Metro Council legislative districts. The Metro Council will adopt or amend the proposed ordinance. The ordinance will take effect after it is passed by the Metro Council and approved by the Mayor. When the ordinance is approved, that approval will be noted on the Metro Council website:

As soon as the districts have been established, any registered voter of Jefferson County may bring an action in the Circuit Court to enforce the provisions of KRS 67C.135. Any such action brought to the Circuit Court by a registered voter must be done so within twenty (20) days from the time the districts are established. The Circuit Court shall hear the action and, if it finds the Metro Council has violated the provisions of KRS 67C.135, remand the matter to the Metro Council. The Circuit Court, in its discretion, may allow the prevailing party, other than the Metro Council, a reasonable attorney's fee.
