Louisville's Parks and Recreation department is holding lifeguard classes for anyone 16 or older. The classes are **\$200**, or **FREE** if you become certified and come to work for us!

Duties include enforcing rules, monitoring activity, cleanup, water tests and more. You must be able to:

- Swim 300 yards continuously - 100 yards breaststroke, 100 yards freestyle and 100 yards of your choice
- Tread water for 2 minutes, no hands
- Swim 20 yards, dive 10 feet, retrieve a weight, swim 20 yards on your back and leave the pool not using ladder - all within 1 minute 40 seconds

Applicants must provide documentation to be employed by the department. Call for a list of the documents.
