

Pop-Up Drop-Off Accepted Items

Accepted Electronics (limit 3):

- Cell phones
- Compact Discs, CD players (CD cases NOT accepted)
- computers
- copiers
- digital cameras
- electronic game systems
- floppy disks
- microwaves
- monitors
- printers
- scanners
- disk drives
- television sets
- VCRs and VHS tapes (cases NOT accepted)



Accepted Yard Waste:

- Bundled limbs less than 2-inch diameter and 4 feet long
- Leaves/clippings/brush in paper bags or reusable containers
- Wooden pallets

(Yard waste in plastic bags must be emptied into the truck and plastic bags taken back by resident.)

Document Shredding:

Resident must take all containers back with them. They can recycle cardboard boxes at the Household Recycling station.

Accepted Household Recycling:

- Paper: Newspaper, magazines, mail, cups, flattened cardboard
- Cartons: Empty food and beverage cartons
- Plastic: Empty kitchen, laundry, bath bottles and containers
- Glass: Empty bottles and jars
- Metal: Cans, foil pans and wrap

Boxes MUST be empty and flattened! No Styrofoam or plastic bags.

Tires:

- Passenger (car) size or smaller only.
- Limit 4 (we have made exceptions if a resident is cleaning them up around the area).

Prescription Medication:

- No needles
- No syringes
- No Epi-Pens
- No liquids of any kind

Accepted Bulky Waste:

- Bathtub
- Bed set (box spring, mattress, head/foot board)
- Cabinet
- Carpet/carpet padding (rolled)
- Car seat
- Doghouse
- Door
- Fence panel
- Furniture
- Glass
- Ladder (wood)
- Mattress
- Patio chairs (plastic)
- Picnic table
- Plastic pool
- Plastic storage bin
- Playhouse
- Pool cover
- Ride-on toy (no batteries)
- Rug (rolled)
- Sink
- Swing set (wood)
- Toilet
- Trampoline (metal parts go with metal)
- Vacuum/carpet cleaner (if it's made of less than 50% metal)
- Vanity

Accepted Metal:

- Basketball hoop/goal
- Barbecue grill (no propane)
- Bed rails
- Bicycle
- Chain link fence (rolled)
- Dishwasher
- Dryer
- Exercise equipment
- File cabinet
- Fireplace insert
- Ladder (metal)
- Lamp or light fixture
- Lawn equipment (must be drained of fluids; no batteries)
- Oven
- Patio chairs (metal)
- Patio umbrella
- Railing panel
- Range hood
- Screen door
- Stove
- Swing set (metal)
- Trampoline (metal parts)
- Utility cabinet
- Vacuum/carpet cleaner (only if it's made of at least 50% metal)
- Washing machine
- Water heater
- Wheelbarrow

Unaccepted Items:

- Garbage or loose debris – place in regular curbside garbage or take to the landfill or WRC for a fee.
- Concrete, bricks, rocks – try giving away or take to Innovative Crushing 502-776-3507, 2412 Millers Ln, Louisville, KY 40216
- Construction materials – WRC, fees apply
- Items containing coolant – WRC, free
- Paint – latex paint should be dried out and placed in garbage. Oil-based paint should go to HazBin, 7501 Grade Ln
- Batteries – HazBin or Batteries Plus stores, hardware stores take power tool batteries
- Light bulbs – fluorescent tubes and compact fluorescent can be taken to HazBin, 7501 Grade Ln or Batteries Plus stores
- Hazardous waste – HazBin, 7501 Grade Lane
- Boats – salvage yard (since they have a title attached to them, we don't take)
- Hot tubs – WRC (too heavy and bulky for Pop-Ups)
- Tree trunks – up to 3 ft diameter can go to WRC, fees apply
- Items from businesses – WRC, fees apply
- Trailers exceeding 10 ft – WRC, fees apply
