



# Louisville Metro 2021 Eviction Prevention Program Household Rental Assistance

Eligible households may receive assistance for past-due rent dating back to April 2020, plus an additional three months of assistance for future rent payments if needed to ensure housing stability.

## Eligibility Includes:

- Jefferson County residency
- Owe past due rent related to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Household income up to 80% AMI (Area Median Income) within the previous 60 days
- Pays rent that is not subject to change based on income, such as Section 8, HAL, TBRA, etc.

## Required Documents Include:

- Eviction Notice or Past Due Rent (or Past Due Utility Notice, as proof of household financial instability)
  - Copy of picture ID for all adults members (18 and older) in the household
  - Proof of social security for all household members, or ITIN numbers (or proof of age for under 2 years old)
  - Proof of income within the last 60 days
  - Verification of loss of income due to the COVID-19 pandemic
  - Rent Assistance Application Form and Landlord/Tenant Agreement Form\*
