

## Am I eligible?:

### AGE:

- 60+ years
- Must provide proof of age (such as driver's license, birth certificate, military or veteran I.D.)

### INCOME:

185% of the poverty level

- 1 person household less than \$23,828 per year or less than \$1,986 per month
- 2 person households earning less than \$32,227 per month or less than \$2,686 per month

## What can I buy?

Eligible foods means fresh, nutritious, unprepared, locally grown fruits, vegetables, and herbs. Eligible foods may not be processed or prepared. Only fresh, unprocessed fruits, vegetables, and fresh-cut herbs may be provided under this program.



## What can't I buy?

Non-local products are not eligible for purchase with SFMNP coupons. Examples include citrus products such as oranges, mangoes, lemons, and limes; bananas, and pineapples. Or processed foods like bread, jams, meat, eggs, cheese, honey, and nuts.

- Look for produce in \$6 bundles, no change is given for checks
- Use SFMNP checks between June - October 2021 at approved farmers markets
- You receive a total of \$48 in checks (8 checks for \$6 each)
- Sign and date your check
- All items should be purchased the date on your check
- SFMNP checks cannot be replaced
- Ask a farmer for assistance!

## What is SFMNP?

Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) provides income eligible seniors with \$48 in checks per season to purchase fresh, unprocessed, locally grown fruits, vegetables, herbs, and honey at approved farmers markets.

## What are SFMNP Checks?

Eligible seniors receive a booklet with 8 checks and each check is \$6.00. You will sign and date each check you spend. No change is given for checks, so plan to spend at least \$6.00 with any farmer. They also cannot give cash for checks.



## Where do I use them?

Vendors who accept SFMNP checks at farmers markets will display this sign.
