

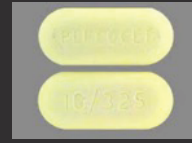

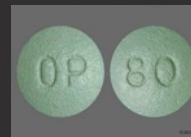

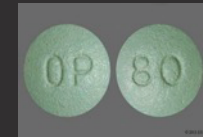

## NEITHER CAN WE

**Counterfeit prescription drugs tainted with fentanyl are flooding Louisville's drug supply. Here are some ways to protect yourself and others:**

- 1) Assume that prescription drugs you buy anywhere but a pharmacy are counterfeit. If you decide to use, try using less than usual and/or change how you use (swallow it instead of snorting or injecting).
- 2) Do not use alone. Try to let someone know that you're going to use and ask them to check back with you.
- 3) Always have overdose reversal drug NARCAN on hand. Free Narcan is available at your local health department, Quick Response Team and most pharmacies.
- 4) Come learn more about harm reduction from the health department, including fentanyl test strips, safe use supplies, resources and the Never Use Alone Hotline 1-800-484-3731.
