

The Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control District (District) opens a public comment period June 23, 2017, on a revised Request for Modification of the Environmental Acceptability Goals of the STAR Program for **American Synthetic Rubber Company** (ASRC) submitted to the District on May 16, 2017.

APCD is incorporating all of the comments it received during two prior public comment periods and at public hearings held on April 19, 2017, and on May 17, 2017, into its evaluation of ASRC's revised Request for Modification. APCD invites additional comments from the public on ASRC's revised Request for Modification.
