Clinic greeters/helpers <b>Newburg Community Center</b> – “Skinny Books”/teaching aides, assist with weekly commodity food distribution, assist with community garden <b>Newburg JB Sutherland Center</b> – “Skinny Books”/teaching aides <b>Newburg Kids’ Café</b> – After school tutors and meal helpers for neighborhood children needing beneficial adult mentoring and good nutrition <b>Uspiritus Youth and Family Services</b> – Tutoring, auxiliary membership, fund-raising for residential abused/neglected youth treatment and recovery center
