## **WHAT IS A TRIAD?**

### **TRIAD is...**

An agreement between local law enforcement, senior service providers and older or retired volunteers in our community to work together for the increased safety & welfare of seniors .

### **TRIAD is...**

A concept of cooperation to reduce criminal victimization of the elderly.

### **TRIAD is...**

A joint approach to crime and safety issues which affect older citizens and the enhanced delivery of law enforcement.

### **TRIAD includes...**

The Louisville Metro Police Department, AARP, and the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office in cooperation with local seniors and service providers.

## **WHAT DOES TRIAD DO?**

### **COMMUNICATES**

by providing a forum for law enforcement and the community to share needs and concerns—and develop solutions.

### **EDUCATES**

through crime prevention programs and victim / witness programs for older persons.

### **EMPHASIZES**

training programs for older persons to reduce fear and provide moral support.

### **INCREASES**

public awareness of safety concerns for older persons and of the need to be alert for signs of elder maltreatment.

### **INVOLVES**

seniors and law enforcement together in developing community-wide solutions.

## **WHAT CAN RESULT?**

### **REDUCE**

victimization of older persons.

### **IMPROVE**

quality of life for older residents of our community.

### **FOCUS**

attention to the crime-related needs and concerns of older persons.

### **EXPAND**

involvement of the community in implementing effective solutions.

### **INCREASE**

community knowledge of services, resources and events.

### **ENHANCE**

law enforcement services to seniors through increased respect and understanding.

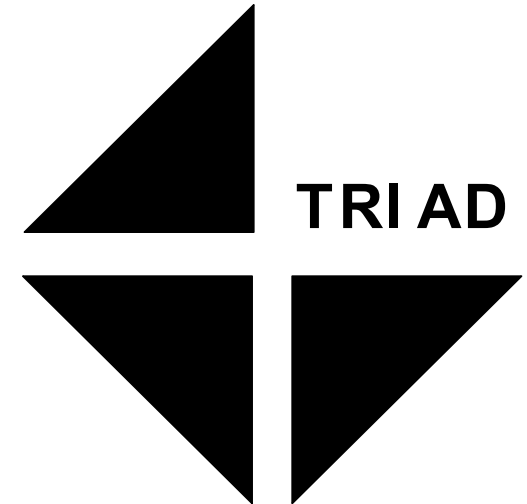
