### TRIAD is...

A national approach to crime and safety issues which affect older adults and the enhanced delivery of law Enforcement services to these persons.

### TRIAD is...

A concept of cooperation to reduce criminal victimization of the elderly.

### TRIAD is...

An agreement in our community to work together for the increased safety and welfare of seniors.

### TRIAD includes...

Law Enforcement, agencies such as AARP, BBB, SMP, the Office of the Attorney General and other senior service providers in cooperation with local older adults.

## WHAT DOES TRIAD DO?

### COMMUNICATES

By providing a forum for law enforcement and the community to share needs and concerns—and develop solutions.

### EDUCATES

Through crime prevention programs and victim/witness programs for older adults.

### STRENGTHENS

Public awareness of safety concerns for older adults and of the need to be alert for signs of elder maltreatment.
