<p>1. THE OWNER AGREES to deposit a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) certified bond, by cash or certified check, with the department as surety, conditioned upon the clearing of the property of all debris resulting from the wrecking operation, the filling of any cellar, cistern, vault or other depression with non-combustible, non-degradable, and non-putrescible materials, and the restoration of the property to its original grade. The cash bond will be returned to the owner when the work has been completed and is in compliance with the conditions stated above. If the owner does not complete the wrecking operation, including the required clearing of the property, the owner will forfeit the bond, unless an extension of time is granted in writing by the Director for good cause. An extension must be requested in writing three days before the expiration of the 30 day wrecking period.</p> <p>2. THE OWNER AGREES that if during the wrecking of the building or structure to the Director or his representative determines that the provisions of City Ordinance or the permit are not being complied with, or that proper safety precautions are not being taken, and or that there is a threat to the safety of persons or property, the Director or his representative may immediately issue an order to cease and desist the wrecking operation. The order may be appealed to the Director within ten days of its issuance.</p> <p>3. THE OWNER CERTIFIES that he understand that the provision of the City Code of Ordinances will govern his work at all times during the wrecking operation at the above location.</p> <p>4. THE OWNER AGREES that the wrecking, removal or demolition of any building or structure will be carried on or executed only by the person, partnership, firm or corporation will be allowed to conduct or carry on wrecking operations under a wrecking permit issued to some other person, partnership, firm or corporation.</p> <p>5. THE OWNER FURTHER AGREES to post the Wrecking Permit in a conspicuous place on the premises.</p>
