Essential Functions	Participates in the academic and physical recruit training programs of the Louisville Metro Corrections Academy Participates in a battery of exams to determine suitability for the position of Correction Officer
Examples Of Work	<p>UNDER CLOSE SUPERVISION</p> <p>Attends classes in personnel procedures, regulations, current laws, the criminal justice system, human behavior and a variety of other topics related to corrections work</p> <p>Learns about various operational units to gain familiarity with the functions of the Louisville Metro Corrections Department</p> <p>Participates in practical training including firearm usage, defensive tactics, arrest procedures, use of corrections equipment and a variety of other procedures and activities related to corrections work</p> <p>Takes tests to measure knowledge gained, evaluates performance and determines progress made</p> <p>Participates in physical fitness and strength training</p> <p>Performs related work</p>
Physical Requirement and Working Conditions	<p>Meets regular and punctual attendance standards and any special needs of the position as determined by management, including mandatory overtime and performing related work</p> <p>Lifts and carries items weighing in excess of 100 pounds in a team setting</p> <p>Physically restrains persons in the course of corrections training activities</p>
Minimum Requirements	High school diploma or the equivalent
Other Minimum Requirements	<p>Must be a US Citizen</p> <p>Must be a minimum of 21 years of age</p> <p>Applicants who have bought or sold marijuana within three years of application, or have bought or sold any controlled substance or narcotic drug without a prescription within six years of application will be disqualified</p> <p>Must not have been convicted of a felony or have any criminal action pending against them</p> <p>Misdemeanor convictions will be considered on an individual basis</p> <p>Must submit to a pre-employment drug screening</p> <p>Must submit to a pre-employment polygraph test</p> <p>Must pass a pre-employment physical, stress and medical examination</p> <p>Must wear personal protective equipment as mandated by OSHA</p> <p>Must wear safety equipment as mandated by OSHA</p> <p>Must be vaccinated for hepatitis B, have provided evidence of immunity, or have signed a declination form within ten days of initial assignment</p> <p>Must pass an annual tuberculin test</p>

Must work a varied schedule
Must not be a current user of illegal drugs
Must not be prohibited by federal or state law from possessing a firearm
Must be eligible for certification as a State Peace Officer
Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license
