

COVID-19 Precautions and Procedures

Jefferson Memorial Forest (JMF) is dedicated to protecting the health of all community members. While programming with JMF we ask that you follow all health and safety procedures outlined in this document. Only medical exceptions will be permitted.

JMF Health and Safety Precautions:

All staff and volunteers facilitating programming must complete an on-site health screening that includes a no-touch temperature check. All staff and volunteers facilitating programming will wear the necessary personal protective equipment (PPE) while preparing for and during the event. Any materials or tools that must be shared will be sanitized before and after the program using CDC guidelines. Groups will be capped at 10 individuals to maintain proper safe social distancing. All staff and volunteers facilitating programming will practice social distancing at 6 feet apart wherever possible.

Participant Health and Safety Expectations:

Before beginning any program, each participant must complete an on-site health screening that includes a no-touch temperature check. Whenever possible, participants should maintain a social distance of 6 feet apart. Participants will be asked to wear a face covering anytime that a social distance of 6 feet cannot be maintained. All participants **MUST** provide their own personal protective equipment (PPE) including a face covering. All participants should bring their own water and drinking vessel. Communal drinking water will not be provided. Hand sanitizer will be provided whenever possible.
