Watch for symptoms

Symptoms of HEPATITIS A infection

- Fever
- Fatigue
- Headache/body ache
- Loss of appetite
- Nausea
- Stomach pain
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Yellow skin and eyes
- Dark colored urine
- Pale colored stools
