



Temporary Tattoo Studio Requirements

The following is a list of items that are required for each studio prior to opening. If a studio has more than one station each station is required to have these items excluding handwashing station and autoclaves).

It is a good idea for event coordinators to have these items available for studios in case they forget to bring them.

- Each studio must have their own hand washing station including – antibacterial soap (green soap is not acceptable, it is not antibacterial), disposable paper towels, spout type cooler with warm water & container to catch waste water
- Trash can with lid
- Bleach solution for trash – containers must be labeled
- Anti bacterial ointment
- Germicidal spray for tables & chairs
- 24 sets of dated needles / expire after 6 months
- Sharps container for needles
- Disposable latex gloves
- Plastic sheets to apply over floor if carpet
- Plastic garbage bag to cover chair
- Aftercare instructions
- Record documents to be kept for 5 years with Name/signature of client, address, Artist, tattoo design & location on body
- Everything needs to be single use
- NO Food, Drink or Smoking at stations
- Clients advised of risks before tattoo administered
- Lighting for booth – 20 foot candles at 36 inches off ground
- An auto clave is needed on site, not per studio
- Body piercer will be required to be in a separate area with an enclosure of walls or curtains
- Artists will be required to wear clean clothes of short sleeve shirts, long pants, and closed toe shoes
- If clients will be under 18, a signed consent & notarization will be required

Studio Certification Fee = \$100 / per studio (A separate studio Certification is needed for Tattooing and Body Piercing)

Artist Registration Fee = \$20 / per artist. (If currently registered in Metro Louisville, exempt).
