How Can I Qualify for Lead Safe Louisville?

These qualifications are based on your annual household income and eligibility can be determined by completing an application with LSL. Here are some questions to see if you may qualify:



Does a child under the age of 6 live at the home?



Was the home built before 1978?



Does your entire family income fit into one of the categories below?

Lead Safe Louisville is in partnership with the Louisville Metro Department of Public Health and Wellness's **Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program** to eliminate lead hazards in both owner-occupied and rental units .

What is the Lead Safe Louisville Project?

People assisted through this program can be homeowners, tenants or landlords, though the homeowners and tenants must meet the income qualification of at or below 80% of the area median income guidelines for a single family unit, or 50% for multi-family units like apartments.

Additional Services Through LSL:

- Information and education about lead poisoning
- Lead training classes
- Referral lists of certified lead contractors
- Gardening tips to enhance the property and achieve lead safety
- Advice about safe and affordable abatement methods
 - Inspections and risk assessments for qualified property owners
