**EXECUTIVE ORDER REOPENING PARKING GARAGES AND STREET PARKING
ON SPECIFIC STREETS IN DOWNTOWN LOUISVILLE**

WHEREAS, events occurring throughout the United States and within the Commonwealth of Kentucky may cause civil unrest requiring preparation, planning and management by Louisville Metro Government in order to respond to any event or situation that occurs as a result of any such events;

WHEREAS, as a result of the potential for civil unrest to occur at and subsequent to the announcement by the Attorney General in the Breonna Taylor case I declared a Second State of Emergency due to the potential civil unrest in Executive Order 2020-014;

WHEREAS, I mandated the closure of specific parking garages and street parking on specific streets in downtown Louisville in Executive Order 2020-15;

WHEREAS, the necessity for the closure of the parking garages and street parking to the extent set out in Executive Order 2020-15 has passed;

WHEREAS, over the last one-hundred-plus days, protesters have regularly gathered in downtown Louisville, particularly in the area of 6th Street and Jefferson, as the epicenter for their protesting;

WHEREAS, the closure of some streets to vehicular traffic of non-residents and of persons without legitimate business or employment purposes is necessary for safety concerns;

WHEREAS, it is my hope that this Order can be rescinded in short order due to the absence of unlawful assemblies and otherwise unlawful conduct; and

WHEREAS, KRS 39A.180 and KRS 39A.100 vests the Chief Executive Officer of a consolidated local government with the authority to issue executive orders necessary for disaster and emergency response purposes and to supplement the execution of KRS Chapters 39A and 39B.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Fischer, as Mayor of Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government, pursuant to KRS Chapters 39A and 39B of the Kentucky Revised Statutes and Executive Order 2020-014, HEREBY REOPEN PARKING GARAGES AND SPECIFIC STREET PARKING IN DOWNTOWN LOUISVILLE within Louisville Metro related to the well-being of our citizens and businesses due to potential unrest. To that end, pursuant to the powers granted me by KRS 39A.100(2)(b), 39A.180(1), and 39B.070, I hereby ORDER AND DIRECT THE FOLLOWING:

1. That effective 12:00 am, September 30, 2020, the following parking garages are reopened for normal business:
 - a. Advocacy Plaza
 - b. 4th Street Live
 - c. Louisville Gardens
 - d. 300 S. 3rd Street
 - e. 6th and Market

2. That beginning 12:00 am, September 30, 2020, the following streets will be closed to vehicular traffic and on-street parking will be prohibited:
 - a. West Jefferson Street between 5th and 6th Streets
 - b. West Liberty Street between 5th and 6th Streets
 - c. 6th Street between W. Jefferson and W. Liberty Streets
 - d. 5th Street between W. Jefferson and W. Liberty Streets

3. Any provisions of Executive Order 2020-215 that conflict with the provisions of this Order are hereby rescinded.

4. This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded by subsequent Executive Order.
