



# District 10 Discounted Recycle Carts

The discounted recycle cart program has been reinstated. The 95 gallon recycling carts are \$50, but if you order through District 10, the cost is \$25. These are available to those in the Urban Services District (the old City of Louisville) that have Metro solid waste service. ## About Recycling

Louisville uses single stream recycling, a method that does not require different materials to be sorted into different bins. We have also made it simple to know what can be placed in your bin.

### What's Permitted

- Paper and cardboard (anything that tears)
- Flatten what you can to save space
- Cardboard pieces may go beside or under bin
- Collect loose papers in a bag or place in bottom of bin
- Plastic (#1 through #7), glass, aluminum and steel containers
- Drain liquids from all containers prior to putting them in the cart

### What's Not Permitted

- No window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, drinking glasses/mugs, oven/cooking glassware or pottery
- No pots, pans, coat hangers, or paint cans
- No medical waste such as syringes or needles
- Plastic grocery bags should go back to your grocery store for recycling. *Do not put them into your bin.*
- Do not use plastic bags or garbage cans for recyclables

- You may set out as many bins as needed
