There are 16,029 homes and businesses located in Metro Council District 8, and yours is one of the just-275 (1.72%) protected and served by the Louisville Metro Police Department **4th Division**. The rest of District 8 in the Urban Services District is patrolled by LMPD Division 5.

You may have noticed in my District 8 eNews, on social media or in other communications regarding public safety that I often refer to the 5th Division only. Given the District 8/5th Division coverage area described above, I'm sure you can imagine why this is the case.

Notwithstanding, I am sending this letter to let you know and assure you that your safety, and the safety of your family and property, is of equal importance to me. I met with your 4th Division Commander Major Joshua Judah and your 4th Division District Resource Officer Jessica Morrison earlier this week to confirm that 4th and 5th Division public safety efforts are in full, lockstep coordination, and not one street address is subject to unclear or overlapping jurisdiction.
