## **Metro Council meeting Thursday, August 9, 2018**

Louisville – The Metro Council met on Thursday, August 9<sup>th</sup>. Here are highlights of the Council’s meeting.

**Consent Calendar:** All items were passed by a vote of 24 to 0

Item 37 was held at the Council Level until August 23<sup>rd</sup>. the measure is a collective bargaining agreement between Metro Government and the Louisville Metro Traffic Guards Association concerning certain employees of the Louisville Metro Police Department.

**Old Business:**



Item 49 passed on a roll call vote of 20 to 0, 1 Abstention and 1 Present. The Item was a resolution amending Council Policies and Procedures relating to the

spending of a Metro Council District's Neighborhood Development Funds and Office Cost Center Funds.



Item 51 passed on a roll call vote of 21 to 1, 2 Abstentions. The Item was a resolution overturning the decisions of the Landmarks Commission Designating the Property located at 3700 Dutchmans Lane as a local landmark.



Item 55 passed on a roll call vote of 19 to 4. The Item was an ordinance to amend the Metro Code of Ordinances by adding the President of the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 77 Louisville Metro Corrections and the President of the River City Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 614 to the Metro Criminal Justice Commission.
