

McAlpine Locks and Dam



Rules on the Loop

The Louisville Loop is for recreation, alternative transportation, and the enjoyment of all. Metro Parks asks all trail users to abide by the following guidelines:

1. No motorized vehicles except ADA support devices.
2. Keep to the right; communicate before passing. Let other trail users know when you are approaching from behind.
3. Maintain control and safe speed. Adjust your speed to accommodate other users, traffic and trail conditions.
4. Pedestrians have the right-of-way on the Louisville Loop. Bicycle riders and in-line skaters must yield to all other trail users. Parents: please keep children from wandering into oncoming trail lane to avoid accidents.
5. Share the trail and be courteous. The Louisville Loop is a shared-use recreational trail appropriate for walkers, joggers, in-line skaters and bicycle riders. Please respect others, and SHARE THE TRAIL. Some future parts of the path will include separate trails for equestrians.

6. Stop for cross traffic and obey all signage.
7. Please comply with 15 mph speed limit on shared-use path.
8. Do not trespass or cut through adjacent properties or yards to access the Louisville Loop. Stop for cross traffic and obey all signage.
9. Respect the trail environment. Do not disturb the wildlife or the many native plants and wildflowers that grow along the Louisville Loop.
10. Pick up litter and place in trash bins. Please remove all pet waste.
11. Keep pets on short leashes (4-6 feet max.) If using a retractable leash, please keep pets near you.
