## Interpreting the LOOP

There are many "stories" to tell along the LOOP - and these stories are told on interpretive signage along the LOOP. This type of signage is different than the rest of the signs proposed for the system. While the majority of the wayfinding signs are intended to orient and provide direction for users - and potential users - of the trail, the interpretive signage offers the chance to explore the "People, Places, and Purpose" of the region. In order to provide a consistent visual image along the LOOP, the interpretive signage system invites the users to discover the "People, Places and Purpose" behind the many unique attributes, physical / geographic highlights, cultural attractions and historic setting found in the region. The graphic below illustrates the basic components of the interpretive signage system, and the panels to the left illustrate how that system can be applied to tell a variety of "People, Places and Purpose" stories along the LOOP.


