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Application Process:

1. Applications consist of 1) Applicant Information, 2) Getting to Know You, 3) Short Answer, 4) Recommendation Form (only 1 recommendation)
2. Applications will be accepted from March 27, 2015 until April 17, 2015. **Applications are available on the Office for Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods' website and Facebook-To be completed online OR paper**

3. All applicants will be notified no later than April 24, 2015. Selected applicants will be asked to interview with the selection committee (interviews are mandatory for those selected).
4. 2015-2016 Youth Implementation Team will be selected and notified no later than May 4, 2015.

Requirements

- ❖ Be at least 13 years old AND no older than 24 years of age AND live in Louisville, KY
- ❖ Complete the attached application
- ❖ Submit at least 1 Letter of Recommendation

Background & Description: The *One Love Louisville* Youth Implementation Team is a new group that will serve as advisors to the Office for Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods Team and its partners. The team and its partners consist of the following representatives: Mayor, Chief of Community Building, Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods' Director and Coordinator, Louisville Metro Public Health and Wellness representative and Louisville Metro Police Department representative. The **primary goal of Youth Implementation Team is to assist with the execution of the *One Love Louisville: Youth Edition Action Plan*.**

One Love Louisville is a campaign launched in January 2015 by Mayor Greg Fischer's Office for Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods. This campaign focuses on reducing homicide, suicide, and drug overdose rates throughout the city of Louisville with emphasis on youth violence prevention.
