Action steps YOU can take to make your city greener and healthier!



CLEAN AIR

- Sign up for the APCD's [Air Quality Alerts](#) via text or email.
- Attend the [Clearing the Air Community Workshop Series](#) to learn about air pollution.
- Get [rebates](#) when you purchase air-friendly electric lawn equipment.
- Reduce lawn-related emissions by [Growing More and Mowing Less](#).
- Improve air quality by going [idle free](#) with KAIRE. If you can count to ten, car off then!



ENERGY

- Install a cool roof on your home and receive up to a \$2,000 [rebate](#).
- Obtain a [permit](#) for solar installation on your home.
- Be an early adopter of LG&E's [Advanced Meter Program](#) and gain online near real-time access to your energy usage information.



GREENING

- Participate in Brightside's [Community-Wide Planting Day](#).
- Join a [community garden](#) or [start your own garden](#).
- Become a green captain and register your neighborhood for the [Green Living Program](#).
- Help restore Louisville's tree canopy and reduce the urban heat island by [planting a tree](#). Contact the [Division of Community Forestry](#) for volunteer opportunities and events.



TRANSPORT

- Download the [Transit App](#) for TARC and other multimodal transit options.
- Participate in KIPDA's [Every Commute Counts Program](#), and vanpool or carpool to work.
- Explore the [Louisville Loop](#) and utilize the 100-mile trail system for your transport needs.
- Sign up for Louisville's BikeShare Program, [LouVelo](#), and bike to work or school.



WASTE

- Download Public Work's [Recycle Coach app](#) to stay up-to-date on waste and recycling.
- Participate in Brightside's [community-wide cleanups](#) and other [anti-litter](#) efforts.
- Host a [Neighborhood Cleanup](#) by registering your neighborhood with Brightside.
- Request up to two reusable water bottles through Louisville Water's [bottle request program](#).
